Course Objectives

The corporate training is to enhance professional practice of nurses in Orthopaedics and Traumatology for Hong Kong Association of Orthopaedic Nurses (HKAON). The course aims to enhance the knowledge and basic care for nurses who can provide quality nursing care to orthopaedic patients and provide a training platform on basic orthopaedic nursing for nurses who are interested in this field or before taking advanced studies in orthopaedic nursing.

Assessment

1. Students are expected to have 80% attendance, including the compulsory attendance in POP workshop; and

Remark: Students must obtain correct answers at 80% or above in order to pass the course assessment. Each student is allowed to undertake re-examination for once ONLY.

Award

A Certificate of Completion will be issued to participants who have an attendance of not less than 80% and passed the course assessment.
